Military Warriors Support Foundation (MWSF) is a non-profit organization, based out of San Antonio, TX, that provides a variety of support programs to our nation's wounded veterans. The transition back to civilian life can have many hurdles for our nation's returning heroes. There are doctor's appointments, school and work obligations, and various trips to provide the basic needs for a family. Having reliable transportation is crucial in accomplishing these things. For a variety of reasons, this is not always possible for our nation's wounded heroes. To support these heroes, MWSF's Transportation4Heroes Program provides 100% payment free vehicles to wounded heroes and Surviving Spouses of Heroes who have fallen in combat.

What we believe sets our program apart from other vehicle donation programs is that our Foundation retains the title of the vehicle for the first year. During this period, we provide a year of mentoring for the family. Each recipient is given a family and financial mentor to provide them guidance to develop the skills necessary to become happy and successful longterm.

Their Mentor serves as their MWSF primary point of contact. They are there to help schedule their vehicle for pick up and ensure everything goes as smoothly as possible, and will continue to be available should they have any questions regarding vehicle ownership. Their Mentor also guides them through a structured financial mentoring program; including budgeting, savings and debt repayment. As part of the financial mentoring program, our families must also commit to abstain from making purchases on credit or deferred payment options. The absence of a vehicle payment is a wonderful gift and we want to help our families make the most of this opportunity! The goal of this program is to get our families out of debt, pay off any debts they owe on, and save for their future. We want to give our families a stable environment where they may not only focus on their recovery, but also build the foundation for a successful future for their entire family; the vehicle is merely a means for us to do that.
